



The discovery of Jebel Sahaba

Cemetery 117 at Jebel Sahaba is a significant discovery for two reasons: it is one of the oldest formal burial grounds in the world, and it contained the earliest known evidence for inter-communal violence. Dr Fred Wendorf carried out systematic excavations here in 1965 as part of his mission to rescue early sites due to be flooded because of the Aswan High Dam. In 2002 Dr Wendorf donated his scientific collections and archives to the British Museum. This material is a unique resource for understanding the early inhabitants of the Nile valley and how they dealt with environmental change.




