


- This college is *Churchill College*. It has a soul in it because it was named after the person Sir Winston Churchill, who was the prime minister winning the war against Germany during the World War II time.





# Cambridge: "A City inside the University"


What does **Cambridge** have?

Cambridge is not only about the University which consists of 31 colleges but

a city, where people can stay over for a couple of days just to explore and have fun. There is a museum called Fitzwilliam Museum which is just a few miles away from City Centre.

# How Cambridge is linked with this: A place for elites only? University of Cambridge is known as a world-class Educational institution at all time and those who study there are known as elites; after this trip, my teammates and I found out something and this is how the city has made itself that way: putting city and University in ONE. It is known that the city Cambridge and the University of Cambridge are closely linked together because there is no line differentiating these two areas; people visit colleges as local resorts. If they have more time to spend in Cambridge, they can also go to Science Park or Laboratory for deeper exploration. In fact, people go to Cambridge mostly for visiting colleges and thus explore how learning is made possible. As a matter of fact, people are provided with an excellent learning environment in the renowned colleges. By exploring the colleges and asking my short-term supervisors questions regarding the learning environment, I learned more about the Education system and why colleges continue to be famous for more than 800 years till now both for its reputation and popularity.

#### The College System

There are in total 31 colleges for all students taking different degrees and majors in various subjects;

#### What is College?

College is a place where students and teaching staff stay and it is like dormitory but the College in Cambridge also has various buildings (i.e. Library, Church and Dining Hall) for residents of the college use.

#### What is it for?

A college not only enables students to rest but to chat and have fun. For instance, students can use the college facilities like Study room or Gym room for relaxing activities or they can even read and go picnic anytime on

the grass field provided. In addition to that, students are encouraged to speak and share their ideas with their peers during the meal time in the dining hall and the topics vary from students' majors to current issues.

#### How important it is for students' overall development?

Having said that students are provided opportunities to chat and enjoy their campus life in college, they are also assigned with a supervisor of their field to help with their academic (and usually research) study; a mentor and a tutor dealing with their social life and financial problems; this is to guide and help students to ensure they are well taken care of and this system is known as the supervision system. Students can all benefit from it and thus develop their own ability to learn and tackle problems. The best thing about this system is that every student is guaranteed a specialist of their field to help them throughout the academic year and they can always discuss anything of their concerns with their supervisor and a student will meet his supervisor once a week at least (after interviewing with the students studying in University of Cambridge).

here is how it is: Both teaching and learning are promising and inspiring




